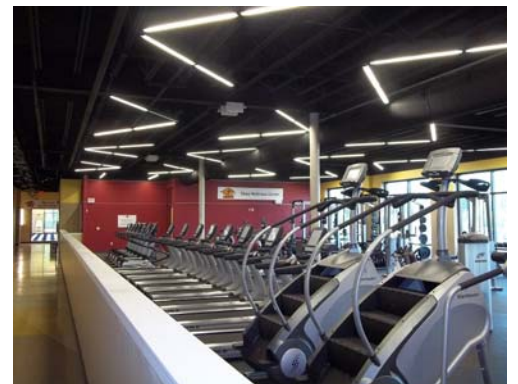

Project Summary:

New 73,600 SF indoor athletic center for small private college in northeast Georgia. The structure is two stories with the first level housing a 1,200 seat basketball and volleyball gym, student dining café, eight lane bowling alley, student workout / wellness center, eight lane 25 yard competition swimming pool, locker rooms, and training room facilities. The upper level program includes the athletic department offices, press box, team video viewing area, and an Alumni / VIP suite overlooking the basketball court with direct access to a special seating area atop the bleachers.

The new athletic center is a pre-engineered metal building with brick and synthetic stucco entrance elevation oriented toward a new 240 space parking lot. The interior features a full service café providing additional on-campus dining option for students. The center provides space for competition basketball, volleyball, swimming, water polo, and bowling as well as intramural, recreational, and wellness activities for the general student population.

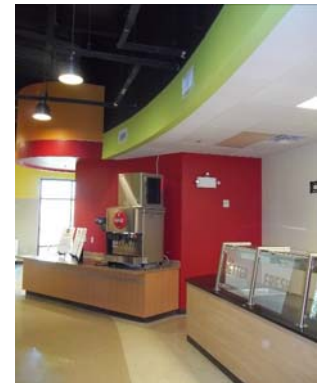
